## CANADA

In autumn 2016, EMG supported the German family von Holger and Claudia Theobald in their assignment to Canada. Following the call of God they handed over their house and garden in Berlin to a family friend and packed the whole household into a huge container to support the establishment of the Kingdom of God at Winkler and Morden in anitoba, Canada.

Their new family home is close to Christian friends and Holger's new job. In addition, the Theobald family have received a house as a gift from Canadian brothers and sisters, which will be transferred to the property, to serve as a building block for the **expansion of a Worship-Project**. The eldest daughter wants, after her wedding with her husband, to receive guests and helpers from other parts of Canada and from Germany to the premises.





Holger offers a supra-congregational course on refugee work in the Community-Church of Gnadenthal south of Winkler and serves the brothers and sisters there through preaching and Bible teaching. Wife Claudia supports families with her pedagogy training and experience.

Since spring 2017, an **international Glory-Community and the "Mandelzweig School of Revival" with a focus on worship and evangelism** on the building site in Tinker Creek is under construction. With other brothers and sisters who have similar visions, a good cooperation has developed in a short time. During the winter months, when the roads are frozen, joint trips are made to the First Nations reservations.
